Although Schell's career at North Central had many ups and downs, he was a part of some of the most historic seasons in North Central Baseball history. In his 4 seasons at NCC, the Cardinals were one of the top teams in NCAA D3 Baseball. The team won 3 regular season CCIW Conference titles, 2 CCIW Tournament titles, appeared in 2 NCAA D3 Regionals (winning 1 in 2017), and finished in the semifinals at the D3 College World Series. "My senior season in 2017 was a season I will never forget. Finishing my career at the College World Series as the most successful team in school history was something I never envisioned and I'm blessed it ended the way it did" Schell says.

Schell joined the Baseball Institute in the winter of 2016 while he was still a senior at NCC, and has been with the company the past 2 years. "My brain is constantly thinking about baseball, so being able to teach what I know to the younger generation, nothing beats that." Although Schell never played professionally, he still brings years of experience with him to help teach the youth in all areas of the game, his specialties being hitting, pitching, and fielding (both infield and outfield).
